Roger D. Thorne joined the Tredyffrin Easttown Historical Society in 2002 after retirement as an industrial facilities services executive, and has actively researched, written and spoken on local history ever since. Of all the history projects he has pursued, Thorne states that the Main Line Airport may be his favorite.

Lt. Col. Kevin J. Berry is Vice Commander of the Civil Air Patrol's 1800-member Pennsylvania Wing. Col. Berry has a master rating in CAP Aerospace Education, holds Emergency Services Specialty Qualifications as a Mission Pilot, Communications Unit Leader and Air Branch director, and has served as both a Group and Squadron commander. Col. Berry, who lives near Butler, PA, is a Registered Nurse by profession, but spends the majority of his time in volunteer service to the Civil Air Patrol.

Bill Holmes is Chair of the East Whiteland Township Board of Supervisors. He began serving on the Board in 2008, and was re-elected for a second term in 2014. A 1986 graduate of La Salle University in Computer Science, Bill has been an Information Technology professional at The Vanguard Group since 1995.

Robert Beggs is co-founder and past Board chairman of the American Helicopter Museum & Education Center in West Chester, PA. He also chaired the AHS International History Committee for many years, and is an expert on the history and development of rotary wing aviation. In 2014, Bob retired from The Boeing Company to lead Good Works Inc, a home repair ministry in Coatesville.

Michelle H. Kichline, Chairman of the Chester County Board of Commissioners, was elected Commissioner in 2015 following a judicial appointment to the Board in 2014. A lifelong resident of Tredyffrin Township, Michelle previously served as a Tredyffrin Township Supervisor. She earned a Juris Doctor degree from Temple University, and spent over a decade as an attorney at Wisler Pearlstine LLP.

Dennis Dispenziere was appointed Senior Vice President and Chief Financial Officer for Ricoh in the Americas on April 1, 2017.
