### Rediscovering Devon

As part of an ongoing collaborative involvement with the Devon Horse Show and Country Fair (DHSCF), members of the Society's leadership were involved in the organization and presentation of a special event held at Chester County Historical Society (CCHS) in West Chester, PA on Sunday 27 October 2013.

The "Rediscovering Devon: An Afternoon of History" event was attended by over 200 people, including a number of the Society's board of directors, and was intended to introduce the ongoing history initiative to a wider audience and promote interest in its further development. Roger Thorne's presentation included some of the remarkable historic images that have been preserved, and was very well-received by the enthusiastic audience.

In addition, many photos, paintings, pieces of sculpture, trophies, and other artifacts were on display in the auditorium and in one of the galleries at CCHS. Featuring a variety of items from collections held by DHSCF, TEHS, CCHS, as well as several individuals, the gallery exhibit was on display for two weeks.

After receiving a very positive response from all involved, it is hoped that there will be future events and exhibitions that will feature new discoveries.
