An Old White Oak

On Thursday afternoon, June 11, 2015, a Rick's Tree Service crew took down a large white oak tree located in the Devon Downs section of Easttown Township, at the south east corner of Watford Lane and Daventry Road (597 Watford Lane). After the Devon Downs subdivision was built in 1962, the tree stood within a few feet of the curb on Watford, leaning in a westerly direction over the street. Last year it appeared to be healthy, but it did not survive the severe winter of 2014–15.

The diameter of the tree stump at ground level, measured after the debris was hauled away, was 53 inches. Using a formula for estimating tree age published on page 23 of the book *Penn's Woods 1682–1982* by Halfred W. Wertz and M. Joy Callender, "for white oak multiply diameter ... by 5," the approximate age of the tree was 265 years.



The "First Purchasers" of Easttown Township land from William Penn sold it off to land speculators. Eventually, a tract of about 100 acres (on both sides of what is today Waterloo Avenue running south down the hill out of Berwyn) was sold to Philip Davies in 1706. The old manor house at 659 Watford Lane in Devon Downs today proudly displays a sign at the curb, "Travelgwyn, 1706." An age of 265 years for the old white oak would put the beginning of its growth within a few decades of the early settlement.
